All the **FLORIDA RAIL FAIR** shows will be held at the Tommy E. Lawrence Arena. This outstanding facility, with 22,000 square feet, continues to provide both customers and dealers with convenient free parking and easy access for loading and unloading. The Volusia County Fairgrounds is well known throughout Florida and is located off I-4, exit 118 A, with the Tommy E. Lawrence Show Arena located at the south end of the fairgrounds.

The kids ride on train will also be setup for all of the upcoming shows in DeLand and Tampa. We will again have a second larger building for the January 2018 show, which is dedicated to operating layouts and displays. The Townsend Show Arena is located across from the Tommy E. Lawrence Show Arena.
